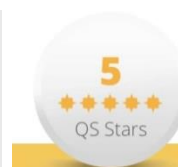

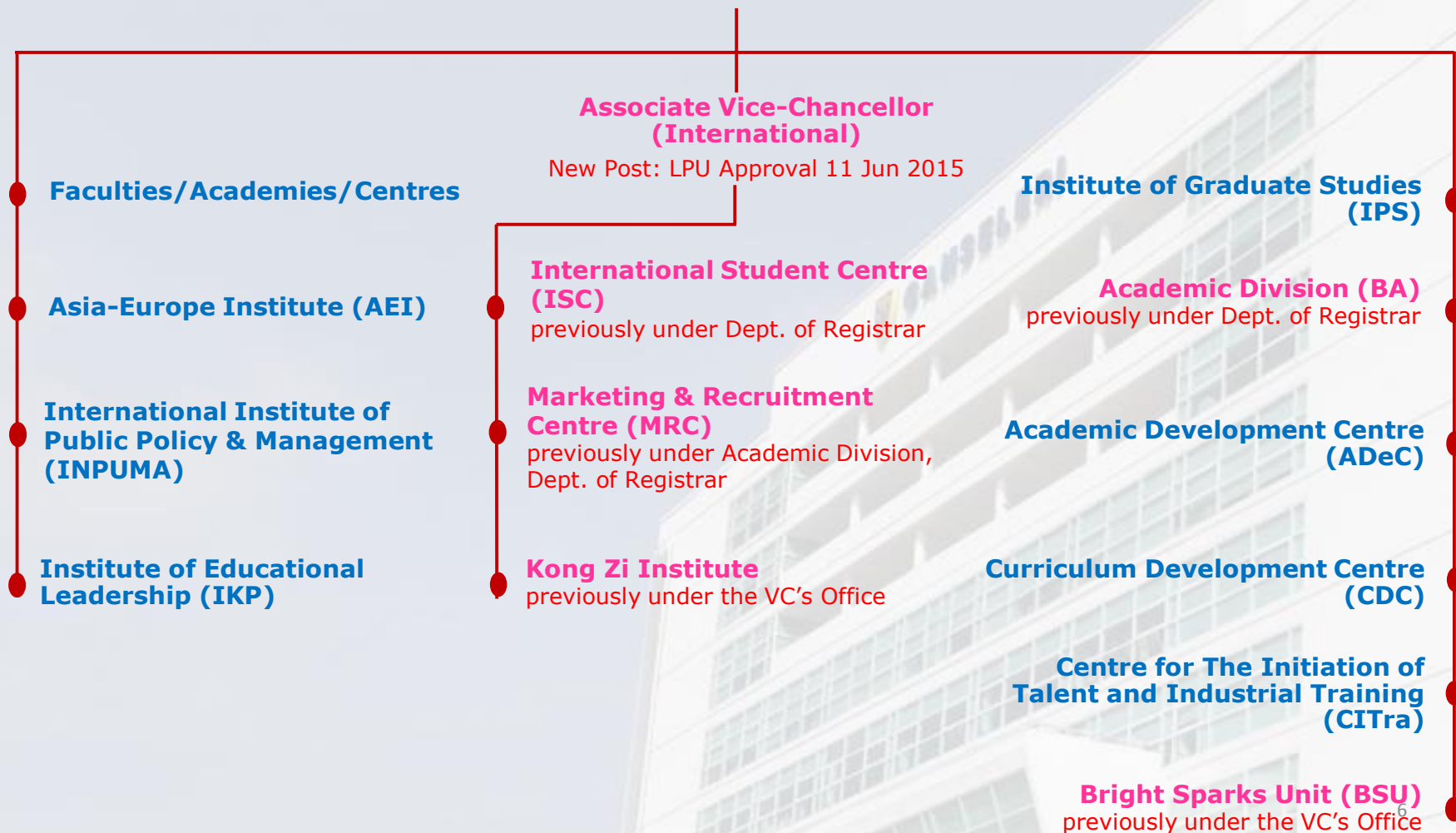


Current Organisation Chart

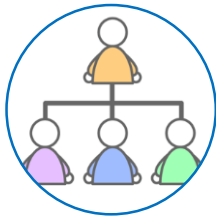

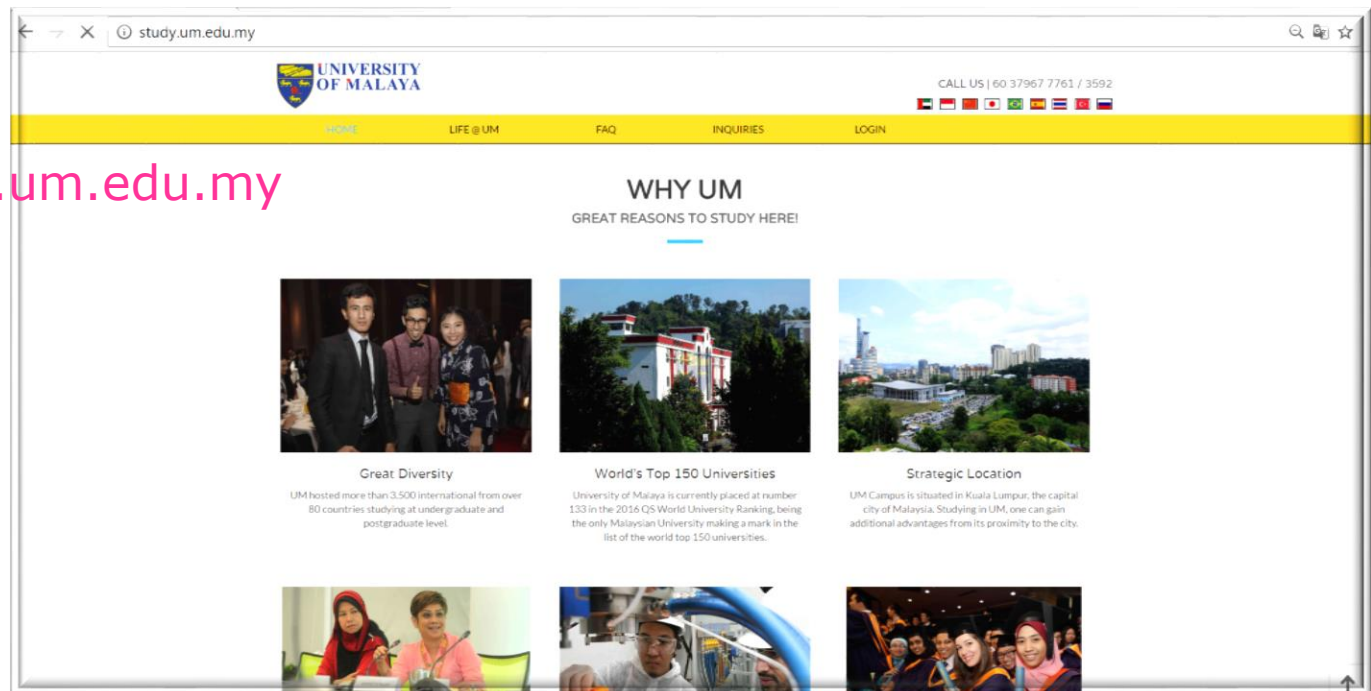

Summer Enrichment Programme (SEP)

SEP offers a "real-life" experience that is second-to-none, and you will find that it could be the one of the most rewarding parts of any international experience. Our 3-week Summer Enrichment Programme is an ideal way to expand your global perspective and sharpen your cultural awareness.

Fees: USD 1,200 (3-week programme) / USD 1,500 (4-week programme)

(Includes 90-150 hours of tuition, airport transfer and ground transports, accommodation, daily meals except on weekends, traditional and cultural activities, homestay programme, field trips and excursions, community engagement, city and Long-haul trips every weekend)

Intensive English Language Programme (IELP)

This programme focuses on developing communicative language skills and confidence through practical activities in an English speaking environment in a multi-cultural context. It is suitable for those who wish to enhance their English language skills in all four areas – listening, speaking, reading and writing.
